The Chemical Abuse Prevention Program (CAPP) promotes wellness and a drug free lifestyle in LISD students.

Did you know that **adolescent substance use is the #1 public health concern** nationwide, AND that most parents don't know their child is using alcohol, tobacco, or other drugs for two years, AND youth become addicted to substances at a faster rate than adults (a few months to 2 years) due to their developing brain's increased vulnerability to drugs?

CAPP services for the prevention and early intervention of alcohol, tobacco, or other drug use (ATOD) include:

1. Voluntary Drug Testing Program– random or family request (twice/year) using saliva swabs. **To enroll your child**, complete the attached form and return it to your child's campus receptionist.
2. Individual and Group Counseling
3. Substance Abuse Assessments to ascertain if your child is experimenting, using, abusing or dependent upon substances.
4. State-Mandated Tobacco Awareness Classes
5. ATOD Prevention Education- Students & Parents.
