
## **WORKING TOGETHER TO BUILD SUCCESSFUL FUTURES**



The <u>Chemical Abuse Prevention Program</u> (CAPP) promotes wellness and a drug free lifestyle in LISD students.

Did you know that adolescent substance use is the #1 public health concern nationwide, AND that most parents don't know their child is using alcohol, tobacco, or other drugs for two years, AND youth become addicted to substances at a faster rate than adults (a few months to 2 years) due to their developing brain's increased vulnerability to drugs?

**CAPP services** for the prevention and early intervention of alcohol, tobacco, or other drug use (ATOD) include:

- Voluntary Drug Testing Program random or family request (twice/year) using saliva swabs.
  To enroll your child, complete the attached form and return it to your child's campus receptionist.
- 2. Individual and Group Counseling
- Substance Abuse Assessments to ascertain if your child is experimenting, using, abusing or dependent upon substances.
- 4. State-Mandated Tobacco Awareness Classes
- 5. <u>ATOD Prevention Education- Students & Parents.</u>
